Dental implants ...

- ▶ Look, feel and function like natural teeth, while preserving the bone and neighboring teeth.
- ➤ Are permanent, reliable and designed to last a very long time without the need for further treatment. Supported clinical research state an implants lifespan to be over 25 years.
- Will function like natural teeth, restoring your ability to chew through a wide range of food items at various levels of hardness.
- > Prevent bone loss and gum recession.
- ➤ Give superior esthetic results to improve your speaking confidence and esthetic cosmetic appearance, giving you a perfect smile again.

Dental implants require the same care and treatment as your own natural teeth. They should be brushed and flossed regularly in order to keep them clean and plaque free.

Standard Surgical Implant Procedure:

- **Stage 1:** A qualified dentist will thoroughly examine your teeth.
- Stage 2: A panoramic X-ray and/or CT will help your dentist determine your bone density, shape of your jaw and determine your personal implant treatment procedure.
- Stage 3: The implant(s) is/are surgically inserted.
- **Stage 4:** 3-6 months healing period while osseointegration (implant bonding to bone) takes place.
- **Stage 5:** Loading of tooth or teeth to the inserted and stable dental implant.

What Are Dental Implants?

Dental implants are small, sturdy, titanium screw-like posts that are surgically inserted into the jaw bone underneath the gums.

Dental implants are designed to perfectly integrate with the human jaw bone and act as permanent artificial tooth root structures to support single or multiple teeth replacement.

Single Tooth Restoration:

A dental implant is the most advanced and effective way to replace a single missing tooth, while maintaining a natural look and feel, yet preserving the bone and neighboring teeth.



Multiple Teeth Restoration:

Dental implants are the ideal alternatives to dentures, which chafe gum tissue and cause bone lose. Multiple dental implants are used to perfectly support a bridge and/or replace several missing teeth while keeping your jaw healthy and esthetically pleasing.



Full Mouth Restoration:

(Edentulous – without teeth)

For patients who are edentulous and need a full mouth restoration, dental implants provide the best solution. Insertions of several implants with crowns provide you with permanent teeth and restore your confidence in your natural smile.

Implants can also help stabilize and support dentures. Although, dentures are not considered the best alternative for natural teeth since they can shift and move during usage, causing gum sores, bone lose, reduced chewing ability and increases general discomfort.
